Please be specific including the following information:

1. <u>Cover Letter</u> stating why you are applying for the scholarship.

## 2. Please use this format when completing your packet:

<u>Section A</u>- Your career goals and reasons why you have chosen the field of teaching, include any teaching experiences you may have already taken part in.

<u>Section B</u>-Information about yourself and your family. Include in this section your name, address, home and/or cell number, email address.

Section C-How would this scholarship help you financially realize your goals?

<u>Section D</u>-Information on your school activities (include sports, honors, awards/activities completed with pride).

<u>Section E</u>-Information on your community activities (Volunteer Experiences, employment, church activities, and organizational activities outside school).

- 3. <u>Two Letters of Reference</u>- one from a teacher, the other from an adult familiar with you (other than a parent/guardian)
- 4. Your Most Current Transcript of Grades / GPA from MHS.
